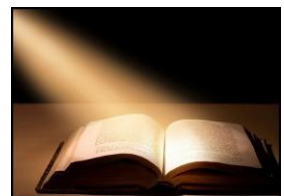

CONSTITUTION

Mission Statement

This organization of charitable riders known as SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC is an organization of fellow motorcycle riders who are confirmed Freemasons of the First, Second or Third degree in a Blue Lodge; otherwise known to be Entered Apprentices, Fellow Crafts or Master Masons. Our club is organized as a proper and traditional Motorcycle Club (MC) to sustain that order and governance that we have learned as Masons to obey and work together under. Without order we would have chaos and thus lose the light that we have come so far to find.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC was established to provide a Global organization for Freemasons who ride motorcycles for the love and life of it and want the world to see that we, they, each one of us, is a proud and speculative Mason. That we can come together in a common interest, using our individual trowels to spread that cement of Brotherly love that binds us into a common band of brothers, Charity and Motorcycles.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC was organized by taking the best of experiences in the RA (Riders Association) and MC (Motorcycle Club) worlds, and smoothing the rough ashlar by our lessons learned in those arenas, building an MC organization that sets its cornerstone in the principles of Blue Lodge Masonry.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC are Master Freemasons riding in and with the Global Motorcycle Community as charitable riders serving our fellow riding friends and brothers aright as we would service our Lodge Communities in their time of need.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC is not an MC of Chapters or Clubhouses. We are a virtual Chapter of Freemasons, riding separately or together with a common cause and mission:

- To represent our proud membership in Freemasonry.
- To share that which is good among us as working brothers to support and put forth a helping hand to anyone we should come across, more especially a fellow Brother Mason and his family, so long as our individual or collective cable tows will permit.
- To bring the image and experience of the partial light we have found in Freemasonry to those Men who seek the light and wish to follow the path of Masonry under their own desires.

SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC By-Laws

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC would in essence become living examples and billboards for Freemasonry around the world, virtual billboards for society to look and see how good and great a work we can do.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC is an organization of riders, governed by a common set of By-Laws, riding under the single rocker of our MC and displaying the great and pure tools of a Master Mason, the Square & Compasses. The governing bodies and officers, along with the trademarked rocker of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC are property of, and controlled by, the membership of Brothers who form the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC. No one single group of Brothers (aka "Founders") will have control over this MC. All governing decisions will be made by the Officers of this organization in accordance with the governing By-Laws of the same. All Members will have a common voice to be heard in the direction and mission of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC .

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Brothers are motorcycle riders that alone or together stand proudly among all riders of the road regardless of their clubs colors or affiliations. Our only affiliation that we will wear is that of our Masonic Obligation in the centers of our backs. We do not judge others but stand on the level with all mankind only judging ourselves, individually, on how well we fulfill our Masonic obligation.

As an MC, SEEKERS of the LIGHT members understand and respect the sacred customs, protocols and code of conduct of ALL organizations of motorcycle riders. We cannot, and will not, affiliate with any MC or Rider Organization. We will, however, stand by the side of and extend a hand to any fallen rider or his family that are in need of our assistance so long as our Cable Tow permits and we do not place ourselves, our Brothers or Family members in harm's way.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Members will defend themselves, this club and any brothers from all external cowans, eavesdroppers and threats as an MC of Brothers, but we WILL NOT hold our MC COLORS above our individual obligation taken to each other as BROTHERS and will always step from our MC COLORS and defend those true colors of BLUE LODGE Principles.

As MASONS, The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC are proud to ride and show the world the same by the colors on our backs that unite us with millions of Brothers across the globe. We do not hold our MC COLORS or Rocker above any other group of Masonic Riders but unite with them on the roads worldwide to show our UNITED COLORS under the Square and Compasses of Freemasonry. Come join with us and spread that cement of Brotherly Love wherever your travels may take you.

And above all, each SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC member will be required to admonish his fellow Members and Brothers by reproofing his brethren gently, but firmly. We firmly believe in the most exacting duties in the ethics of Freemasonry;

... a Mason should not publicize the faults of a Brother Mason, but shall whisper good, private counsel in his ear. An admonition must be given in the language of brotherly affection, the magic tongue of love, and with the persuasive attitude of 'mercy unrestrained'...

So Mote It Be.

Article 1 – Identity

Section 1 - Name.

The MC will be known as **SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC aka "SEEKERS MC"**

Section 2 - Territory.

The **SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will be known as a "global" or "worldwide" organization of riders and will not claim any specific state or country as "territory."**

Section 3 – Address.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will maintain a mailing address at the following address, but not limited to that address for additional club activities when identified to members:

Section 4 – Chapters.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will have no "clubhouses" or "chapters" outside of the Mother Chapter.

Section 5 – "Nomad".

All SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Members will wear a "NOMAD" front patch to designate that there are no clubhouses or chapters, and that we do not claim any territory.

This form of identification has been traditionally used by the MC, 1% and Outlaw community throughout the globe.

Section 6 - Classification.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will be referred to as a "Motorcycle Club of Charitable Works".

Article 2 - Membership

Section 1 - Who.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will be comprised of motorcycle owners and riders who share the common bond of Blue Lodge Brotherhood and have an interest in doing charitable acts for fallen riders and families in the motorcycling community. Members must have and maintain an active membership in their home Blue Lodge in order to qualify for and maintain membership in the SEEKERS MC.

Section 2 - Requirement.

Members will be required to maintain their status commonality of Article 2 – Section 1. If a member leaves or is expelled from Masonry his membership in the SEEKERS MC is automatically terminated, and all Club property must be returned to the Club.

Section 3 - Avouching.

Applicants will provide supporting documentation to an officer of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC before engaging in club discussion or being given a copy of the By-Laws for their review.

Those supporting documents will consist of:

1. Copy of valid Driver's License with photo
2. For EA & FC candidates, the Lodge Name, Number, City & State of their membership along with Name & Contact information of your recommending and avouching Brothers.
3. For MM candidates, copy of signed current Blue Lodge card.

Section 4 - Preparation.

Once an Applicant is found to be worthy and well qualified he shall then be provided a copy of the current SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC By-Laws for review by the Guardian of Membership or by any "prime" officer of the club.

Section 5 - Applying.

If a worthy and well qualified Applicant finds the By-Laws to their satisfaction and wishes to gain admission into the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC, that applicant shall request an APPLICATION for MEMBERSHIP from the Guardian of Membership or any Prime Officer of the club.

Section 6 - Submission.

All Applications for Membership will be received through the email box of *Membership@Seekers-MC.com*.

Section 7 – Validation of Candidates.

Upon receipt of any application for Membership into the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC it will be validated for:

1. Identity.
2. Active Status of Article 2 - Section 1.
3. Completeness.
4. Proper signatures where required.
5. Suggested Charitable Donation. Amount suggested is \$185.00 which will be applied to the cost of the patches and includes the candidate's first year dues.

Section 8 – Acceptance of Application.

Upon the Acceptance of an Application for Membership, the following actions will be taken by either the President, Vice President or Secretary:

1. Sign the application as a club officer.
2. Register the Applicant as a "Member in Full Standing" in the club records.
3. Forward the donation to the club Treasurer.
4. Notify the Guardian of the Applicant's State.
5. Make the appropriate communication on the new member to all SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC members through Facebook and e-mail.
6. Forward the signed application and all associated documents to the club President for final inspection, acceptance and archiving.

Section 9 – Denial of Application.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC President and Vice President have the right to deny, revoke or veto any application for membership. The President has the right to overturn a denial, revocation, or veto from the Vice President; the Vice President does not have the right to overturn a denial, revocation, or veto from the President.

Section 10 – Denial Overturn.

The Prime Officers (see article 3, section 2) of the club have the right to request an officer vote to over-turn any application denied, revoked or vetoed by the President after both the President and a representative of the Prime Officers have presented opposing statements to the Prime Officers.

Section 11 - Receiving.

A member in full shall share in all the benefits, activities and communications of the club. This includes access to any club materials that are made available for club promotion. Access to the secured web page containing all shared materials will be granted to the newly admitted member.

A patch set will be shipped either to the member's Guardian for formal presentation or directly to the member, depending upon geographic location and proximity of the Guardian to the member.

A "patching ceremony" letter will be sent from the President to the newly admitted member.

Section 12 - Prospecting.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC, in accordance to the By-Laws revisions of 2020, will have prospect or "slick back" membership.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will allow Membership Inquiries and applications from EA and FC Brothers.

Those applicants will have their standing as EA and FC Brothers verified through their Recommending and Avouching Brothers at their respective Lodge, by the President or his duly appointed representative.

Upon acceptance into membership of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC, they will be given a patch set containing ONLY the Upper Rocker of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC and NOT the S&C Center Patch.

They will be given one(1) calendar year, 12 months, from the time of their acceptance into the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC to achieve the Status and Title of 3rd Degree or "Master Mason" at which time they will be presented with the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Center patch consisting of the pure symbol of the S&C.

No member shall have the right or privilege of wearing the S&C until such time that they are able to present a valid and signed Blue Lodge membership card indicating their status as a Master Mason.

Any Prospecting Member of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC found to be wearing or displaying the symbols of S&C upon their person before achieving the possession of their Blue Lodge membership card will be brought up on Disciplinary charges (article 7) to be determined by the Prime Officers based on the seriousness of the violation.

A Prospecting Member will have no access to SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC documents or web page.

SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC By-Laws

A Prospecting Member will not utilize a carry card for the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC.

A Prospecting Member may NOT engage in conversation with anyone outside of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC members and Brothers about the club or its members.

A Prospecting Member may NOT attend a public event of another Motorcycle Club or Motorcycle Organization wearing his colors without being accompanied by at least 1 S&C wearing member. He MAY attend on his own without representing the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC and without discussion of his affiliation to the same. Any Prospecting Member found in violation of this edict will be brought up on Disciplinary charges (article 7) to be determined by the Prime Officers based on the seriousness of the violation.

Article 3 - Officers

Section 1- Type.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will be comprised of Officers of two (2) classes:

1. PRIME Officers
2. FUNCTIONAL Officers

Section 2 - Prime.

PRIME officers will be comprised of the following:

1. President
2. Vice President
3. Sergeant at Arms
4. Secretary
5. Treasurer
6. Road Captain
7. Guardian of Membership

Section 3 - Functional.

FUNCTIONAL Officers will be comprised of the following:

1. Individual State/Territory Guardians
2. Chaplains
3. Public Relations officer
4. Foreign Liaison

Section 4 - Identification.

Any member holding an office within the Club, will wear a patch designating their office. This patch will be worn on the front, upper left side of the Club vest as outlined in Article 4 – Patches.

Section 5 - Succession.

The rules of succession between offices will not be practiced within the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC. (Example: If the Vice President were to quit, or not be able to perform his duties, the Sgt. At Arms would not automatically move up into that position because he might not be qualified for or want that position.)

Section 6 - Interim.

If an officer does not, or is unable to perform his duties, or quits his office, it will be the responsibility of the President to appoint someone to that position until the regularly scheduled election.

Section 7 - Meetings.

The PRIME governing officers will meet once every month either in person or through a form of teleconferencing.

Section 8 - Elections.

Elections will be held annually every year on the regular January meeting for any offices vacated during the prior year by a Club vote by the membership present. The voting membership, or FULL MEMBERS, consist of only patched members that wear the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC upper rocker and the Square and Compasses on the back of their Club vest. In the event a tie vote occurs, the final decision will rest with a majority vote by the PRIME Club officers.

Section 8 - Replacing.

PRIME Officers retain their offices unless voted out. Any FULL member wishing to run for an office will submit his name to the Club Secretary by the December General Meeting, prior to the election.

Section 9 – President Resigns.

When the President steps down, the Vice President along with the Sergeant at Arms and Secretary will manage the club until the next President can be elected by the voting membership.

Section 10 - President.

PRESIDENT – Role and Responsibilities.

The President shall preside over all officer and general membership meetings. He will oversee all affairs of the Club and may appoint persons or committees as may be required for Club business. If any officer in the Club is unable to, or fails to perform his duties, it is the responsibility of the President to appoint a replacement until the general election.

Section 11 – Vice President.

VICE PRESIDENT – Role and Responsibilities.

The Vice President shall perform all duties incumbent upon the President during the absence of the President. The Vice President will be the balancing power and the validating voice of reason for all actions of the President.

Section 12 – Sergeant at Arms.

SERGEANT AT ARMS – Role and Responsibilities.

The Sergeant at Arms shall promote unity throughout the Club and will ensure all bylaws and traditions are respected by everyone. His duties include maintaining order during all Club meetings, events and functions, and to protect the rights of the Club and its members. It is also his duty to

manage all complaints and to bring them to the attention of the President. He is the balance of reason and understanding of all by-laws when any member(s) should falter or mis-understand or require guidance when acting in compliance of the Seekers of the Light By-Laws. He is the whispering voice of good advice in all members' ears when he feels it is necessary or sees fit. He may do this one on one or with an entire group with all and any members at his discretion.

Section 13 - Secretary.

SECRETARY – Role and Responsibilities.

The Secretary shall keep a record of all proceedings and shall keep the minutes of all monthly meetings. Within one week of the monthly meetings he will distribute the minutes to the Club membership, either in writing or by email. The Secretary will be responsible for all communications to members requested by the President. The Secretary will also be responsible for tracking and maintain a list of Members, Applicant's, Brothers Inquiring as well as Donations by Members and Applicants.

Section 13 - Treasurer.

TREASURER – Role and Responsibilities.

The Treasurer must account for all income and expenditures of the Club. He will maintain an accounting journal and log all transactions by the Club. He will give a financial report at each monthly meeting showing the current wealth of the Club. He must insure that all disbursements of Club money are approved with the knowledge & approval of the President and Vice President and Secretary. Disbursements of \$100 and under \$500 must be approved by majority vote of the PRIME Club officers. Disbursements of \$500 or more must have unanimous approval by the officers. He will be responsible for collecting any and all Dues or Fees required by the Club.

Section 14 – Road Captain.

ROAD CAPTAIN – Role and Responsibilities.

The Road Captain shall be responsible for the safety of the membership any time the Club rides as a group or as individuals at any events. As the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC is not a band of riding Brothers, The Road Captain will review the trip plans of all members who are planning rides or events which include group rides of some type to assure all safety issues are understood and covered. The Road Captain will assist other riders in practicing safe riding while traveling in formation. He will be responsible for scheduling departure times and locations for trips or rides and will communicate this information to all the membership. In the event that the Senior Road Captain is unable to take part in a Club run or trip, he will pick a Road Captain and two (2) Assistants to lead the Club in his absence, and will

help them in their preparation, if needed. In addition, the Road Captain will assure that any members who are involved in any ride event will be knowledgeable of all safety and ride preparations to assure the safety of those participants. All members will be required to submit a ride/event plan to the Road Captain to review.

Section 14 – Guardian of Membership.

GUARDIAN OF MEMBERSHIP – Role and Responsibilities.

The Guardian of Membership is the point of contact for all Masons who are interested in joining the SEEKERS MC. Upon being contacted by a candidate, the Guardian will forward the candidate's information to the appropriate Country/State Guardian of Membership who will then contact the candidate and begin the vetting process. The Country/State Guardian will be responsible for providing the candidate with a copy of the By-Laws when that part of the process has been reached; he will also be responsible for providing an Application and Application Instruction Sheet to the candidate and will assist the candidate in completion of the form. The Country/State Guardian will ensure that all required supporting documentation is provided by the candidate and will review these documents for accuracy, after which they will be scanned and then forwarded to the membership e-mail for review and/or approval. All forms and supporting documents submitted must be scanned; photographs are not acceptable. After the application and supporting documents have been submitted, the hard copies will be mailed to the Secretary.

Section 15 – Chaplain.

Chaplain – Role and Responsibilities.

It is the duty of each Chaplain to provide spiritual support to any Brother or Member, or member's family during a time of crisis or when it is sought out. The Chaplain is not required to be of any specific denomination in his religious beliefs. The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will attempt to provide Chaplains that are both geographically accessible as well as from different religious denominations and beliefs to offer the proper support to a Member and his family.

The Chaplain will provide prayer during meetings and events to bring us all into the great light of our Grand Architect.

The Chaplain is our guide and tie back to our obligation on that Great Light.

Article 4 - Patches

Section 1 - Patches.

The Club patches will consist of:

ROCKER

A Unique back top rocker that is the proprietary patch for the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC organization. This patch is the ONLY patch that is club property. The rocker has the words "SEEKERS of the LIGHT" in MasonicAlternate font, bounded on each side by the two (2) pillars above which resides the All-Seeing eye above the illuminated Book of our alter.

CENTER

A 12" high back center patch consisting of a Silver embroidered Square and Compasses displaying the "G" in the center.

FRONT MC

A 2"x4" patch that denotes the SEEKERS MC in MasonicAlternate font with the All-seeing Eye and Illuminated Book above. This patch provides club identification to those who approach from the front.

NOMAD

A Front 1"x4" "NOMAD" patch in MasonicAlternate to represent that the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC has no Clubhouses or Chapters in the rider's territory or state.

ROAD NAME (OPTIONAL)

A 1"x4" "NAME" patch displaying the member's road or street name in MasonicAlternate font.

OFFICER TITLE

A 1"x4" "TITLE" patch displaying the member's club Title/Position in MasonicAlternate font, if so appointed to one.

NON-RIDER

A 1"x4" "4WD" patch denoting members who do not ride. This status is denoted by an embroidered single motorcycle tire tread of 2" on the left which then turns into a set of auto tire treads for the remaining 2" across the right, denoting a rider is now "caged".

FLAG of NATION/TERRITORY (OPTIONAL)

A FLAG patch of the members NATION or TERRITORY. For Americans this would be the Red, White and Blue Flag of the USA.

Section 2 - Placement.

Patches will be SEWN onto a black leather vest or riding jacket which will not display any patches other those listed in Article 4, Section 1.

Patches will be placed as such:

ROCKER

It is placed centered on the back across the shoulders approximately 4" down from the top edge of the vest or from where the collar starts on a jacket.

CENTER

It is placed centered on the back approximately 1" bellow the bottom edge of the Top Rocker.

FRONT MC

It is placed on the right front breast immediately above and bordering the NOMAD patch.

NOMAD

It is placed on the right front breast directly below the FRONT MC patch and directly opposite the OFFICER TITLE patch. If not an Officer, then the ROAD NAME patch.

ROAD NAME

It is placed on the front left breast directly above and bordering the OFFICER TITLE patch. If not an Officer then directly opposite the NOMAD patch.

OFFICER TITLE

It is placed on the front left breast directly opposite the NOMAD patch and under the ROAD NAME patch bordering it.

NON-RIDER

It is placed on the front right breast bordering below the NOMAD patch.

FLAG of NATION/TERRITORY

It is placed on the font left shoulder above everything else.

Article 5 - Meetings

Section 1 - Frequency.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT officers will hold a monthly meeting open to all members.

Section 2 - Location.

The monthly meeting will be a Global conference call to accommodate all Members at difference geographic locations.

Section 3 - Scheduling.

The Secretary will communicate the Date and Time of the next monthly conference call at least three weeks prior to that scheduled meeting time. That communication will be made via email and posted on the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC PRIVATE Facebook page. The Date, Time, Time Zone and agenda as given to him by the President will be communicated.

Section 4 – Attendance.

All SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Members must make efforts to attend the monthly conference calls. Each conference call will be recorded and made available for members to listen to the meeting at their convenience. All members who cannot be on the call during its scheduled time must listen to the recorded meeting to be up on the club’s current affairs.

Section 5 - Access.

The conference call phone number, access codes and procedures will be available to all Members in the secured Seekers of the Light online storage area and provided by the Secretary via email when requested.

Section 6 - Officers.

Primary Officers will meet once every quarter either in person or over conference call to discuss the health and welfare of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC and all its members.

Article 6 - Finance

Section 1 - Management.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC finances will be managed by the Treasurer.

Section 2 - Reporting.

The Treasurer will provide a financial accounting of the club at each monthly meeting or whenever the President requests it.

Section 3 – Work Flow.

Monies collected by the Secretary will be accounted for and handed over to the Treasurer for proper handling and accounting.

Section 4 – Initial Membership.

The Secretary will collect donations from new Members in the amount of \$185 USD, log them accordingly and hand them over to the Treasurer.

Section 5 – Continued Membership.

The Secretary will collect donations from all established members annually on or before March 1st of each year in the amount of \$25 USD, log them accordingly and hand them over to the Treasurer.

Section 6 - Donations.

Additional monies donated to the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will be recorded and handed over to the Treasurer for appropriate accounting.

Section 7 – Charitable Giving.

Request from Members for monies to be utilized for any charitable activity will be submitted in writing via email to the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC officers for a vote and approval. Monies approved will be communicated to the Treasurer for disbursement and proper accounting in the club records. A report will be submitted to the members at the following monthly meeting by the Member responsible for the charitable oversight.

Section 8 – Operational Costs.

Monies required for SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC business transactions will be approved by officers and then communicated to the Treasurer for proper disbursement. If the amount required exceeds \$150 USD it will require an informal consensus of all members for a majority approval. This consensus can occur through emails or Facebook.

Article 7 - Discipline

Section 1 - Audience.

All Members of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC will be held accountable to these by-laws.

Section 2 - Instigation.

Any activity or behavior that requires disciplinary action to be invoked will be determined by a hearing of the charges by the Primary officers. A decision will be presented to all Members involved along with the disciplinary action to be taken which may be as high as expulsion from the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC.

Section 3 – Rule & Guide.

A Members Blue Lodge Obligation will always supersede these by-laws. That is to say that all Members will be held accountable to their Blue Lodge Obligation. Any behavior that is not in line with that of a Mason's Blue Lodge obligation will be viewed as actions requiring disciplinary action within this club.

Section 4 – Bottom Line.

All SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Members and any associates who are Masons, while in public, will display the proper conduct and behavior expected by AL Masons while representing this club and Freemasonry when wearing his colors. Improper Behavior as a Mason will be viewed as a violation of these by-laws and treated with the disciplinary action deemed necessary by the Primary officers.

Article 8 - Acceptance

Section 1 – Colors Ownership.

The SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC rocker is the trademarked emblem of the club and cannot be owned by an individual or worn, except he be a member in full standing. Any Brother who leaves the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC by either his own free will or at the request of the club will return the back upper rocker to the current President of the club who will in turn release him from his obligation and notify all Seekers MC club members.

Section 2 – Acknowledgement.

do hereby acknowledge that I understand that the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Rocker is the trademarked colors of the club and that I have no right of claim to the rocker patch when I am no longer a member in full standing.

I agree that under no less a penalty of that of a Mason to his Brother that my word is given to return my SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC Rocker back to the club President upon exiting the club.

I also acknowledge that I understand the written By-Laws of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC and promise to uphold and abide by all decisions made according to them while a member in full of the SEEKERS of the LIGHT MC organization.
